Summary of Tasks

- 3. In groups, add between 2-3 other pros and cons from your thinking or experiences. **5-10min**
- 4. Discussion- write on board best 5-7pros and cons **2-5min**
- 5. Debate
 - a. 2-3 min opening statements 2x(6-8min) 3 reasons each
 - b. Argue best pro versus con **10min**
 - c. Final discussion- till end of class. Why do you think print or electronic is superior? Do you think that paper books will become obsolete in the next 10 years
