Lesson Objective:

Summary of Tasks
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Brief introduction, split class into 2 groups. Assign student as a 1 or 2. <u>2min</u> 2. Assess 10 pros of "The E-book vs. the ordinary book", pick 10 out of first 20 pros. <u>5-10min</u> 3. In groups, add between 2-3 other pros and cons from your thinking or experiences. <u>5-10min</u> 4. Discussion- write on board best 5-7pros and cons <u>2-5min</u> 5. Debate <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. 2-3 min opening statements 2x(<u>6-8min</u>) <u>3 reasons each</u> b. Argue best pro versus con <u>10min</u> c. Final discussion- till end of class. Why do you think print or electronic is superior? Do you think that paper books will become obsolete in the next 10 years
