What are your future aspirations after completing ESAL? (5min)

- Is there a particular job you wish to do?

Vocab (2min)

Ss will write down a potential job they would like to have either now or in the future (15min)

- In groups of 3-4, Ss will briefly describe the job they would like to do.
- Other group members will be asked to give one piece of advice or a recommendation on achieving this goal, or general advice while they are working with it.

Groups will present favourite pieces of advice to class. Class is encouraged to comment or ask questions (5-6min each)
